‘El Destino no tiene favoritos’
(Destiny has no favourites)

Ana is a rich, repressed housewife. Much to her annoyance, her husband rents out their garden to a soap opera production whilst he is away on a business trip. Ana follows the production from her window and starts to become as engrossed in the soap opera as her two maids. When accidentally mistaken for an actress, she ends up being cast for a role. As the set gradually becomes dominated by gossip, intrigue and blackmail, the boundary between the real world and the make believe world of soap operas begins to blur.

Alberto Cabello, a nine year old boy, goes on a school trip to ‘El Real Felipe’, a colonial fortress in Callao, where he gets lost and enters a portal that sends him to the 17th Century. Alberto discovers that Callao is going to be attacked by a group of Dutch pirates led by Jacques L’Hermite who wants to steal the gold of the King and conquer Callao. Will Alberto be able to do something to stop the pirates?

‘Paloma de Papel’ (Paper Dove)

This is the story of a little boy, Juan, in times when inhabitants of the highlands lived between activities from the insurgent groups, the ‘ronderos’ (popular vigilant system) and the armed forces. He finally returns to his home town, surely looking for memories of a childhood that was not completely a happy one, but that had, nonetheless, faces and situations that memory keeps with devotion.

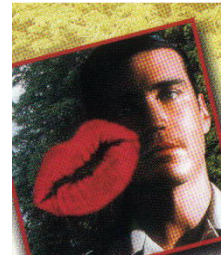

He yearns to be a writer and is convinced this training will help enrich his CV. From the get go, Alfonso is faced with difficult obstacles that he must overcome in order to fulfil his dream. He is assigned to the crime column, where he meets Saul Faundez, and soon Alfonso realises Faundez is a man whose feelings and passions complement the tainted world in which he has chosen to live.

Captain Pantaleon Pantoja arrives in Iquitos to find out that his special task will be to provide 'outlets' for the soldiers quartered in the jungles of the Amazon. What first appears to be a hilarious comedy becomes a rather profound statement about one man's ideals and his dedication to authority: the perfect Military Officer. Captain Pantoja organizes a carefully screened cadre of 'ladies of the night or visitadors' but becomes obsessed with his project and is eventually drawn into an indiscretion with one of the visitadors. From there things begin to lose humour, the project is made public by a radio talk show host, and ultimately, comedy turns into tragedy. The real interest of this film is how despite the ultimate failure of the project, our by-the-book Pantaleon manages to find a way to bounce back.
